A- Height from floor to center of shoulder
B- Length from center of shoulder to front of thigh
C- Width of thigh
D- Height from floor to groin
E- Height from floor to top of rear $\qquad$


Note: A\&E will typically be within 1 inch of eachother
Note: For measurements F, G, and H, make sure the measurement is flat and does not curve down with the dogs body (these measurements are very important as we need the widest point of the dog).
